The amount is credited to the recipient's account on Friday at 14:00. If several payments are sent on the same day with the same payment date, the account must contain sufficient funds to cover the total amount (payment batch) on the day before payment date at 16:00. Otherwise the entire payment batch will be rejected.

Express payments are not possible from accounts in Sweden. Instead order an express international payment from an account with Sydbank. International payments cannot be postdated.

¹⁾ Instead payment to a Plusgiro account can be ordered as an international payment from an account with Sydbank.

²⁾ If the account number/bank giro number is incorrect or if Swift/BIC is missing, a payment advice/“cheque” is sent to the recipient (may be cashed at a bank or post office). Do not use country codes (eg SE for Sweden).

³⁾ Example: Payment must be made on Friday. The payment must be ordered in Online Banking by Thursday before 16:00. The account must contain sufficient funds to cover payment on Thursday at 16:00.

The amount is credited to the recipient's account on Friday at 14:00. If several payments are sent on the same day with the same payment date, the account must contain sufficient funds to cover the total amount (payment batch) on the day before payment date at 16:00. Otherwise the entire payment batch will be rejected.
